



“WHAT DISTRACTED DRIVING MEANS TO ME” VIDEO CONTEST

The Distracted Driving Video Contest *(Please completely read this form)*

Safe Communities Wellington County is pleased to invite community members 19 years of age and under to create up to a 60 second video outlining your views on the **hazards of distracted driving**.

All videos will be judged by Safe Communities Wellington County on creativity, and the ability to convey your message effectively.

Contest begins: Thursday, February 1, 2018

Contest Closes: Wednesday, April 18, 2018

CONTEST DETAILS

Who Can Enter?

All Wellington County Youth 19 years of age and under. Students can earn up to 8 community service hours for participating in the contest at the discretion of your High School. If the contest is assigned as a school project, it is not eligible for volunteer hours.

Rules and Regulations

1. To create a video up to 60 seconds long explaining what distracted driving means to you.
2. Outline the negative consequences of distracted driving, and understanding the laws as they apply to distracted driving.

3. Videos must not depict any brand or logo, or any specific names of organizations (including any familiar songs, jingles or copyright music).
4. Videos must not depict any **illegal activity, criminal offenses, profanity, sex, or violence on individuals or organizations.**
5. **The operation of a moving motor vehicle is not permitted.**
6. All videos should present a problem as well as a solution to the problem in their video.
7. Youth may work on this project as individuals or in groups.
8. **A completed and signed consent form must be submitted with every entry, and all participants appearing in, or filming the video must sign the consent form. This is not negotiable. Your video will not be judged unless these forms are filled out – if you are under 18 years old you must have your parent or guardian’s signature on the form.**
9. Any video that fails to meet the requirements listed above will be **DISQUALIFIED.**
10. Videos must be submitted in mp4 format.
11. Winners will be notified by a member of Safe Communities Wellington County

How to Enter

1. Download the Contest Entry Form from <http://wellington.safecommunities.parachutecanada.org/documents>, and fill in all of the required information.
2. Upload your video to YouTube (free) and include the video URL on the entry form.
3. After the form has been completed and signed, send it to us by scanning and emailing the entry form to safecwcvideo@gmail.com with the name of your video in the subject line.
4. The name of your school (If applicable), the email addresses of all members of your video submission team and a direct link to your video in the body of the email should be included.

Judging and Prizes

Members of Safe Communities Wellington County will judge all videos. However, family members or guardians of individuals involved in submitted videos will not be eligible to judge any video entry.

First Prize for Each Municipality within Wellington County is \$75.00 –
Township of Centre Wellington, Town of Erin, Township of Guelph-Eramosa,
Township of Mapleton, Town of Minto, Township of Puslinch, and Township of
Wellington North.

First Prize Wellington County Overall - \$225.00

Community Service Hours

All High School participants who enter the contest or take part in the filming of a video can apply for up to 8 community service hours. Students must ensure that the Safe Communities Wellington County Video Contest fits within your school community service policy and guidelines.
